2. Education

Passage of 1/4 cent countywide sales tax for education 2013
Renewal of 1/4 cent countywide sales tax for education 2018
Construction of initial phase of the University Center of Southern Oklahoma

3. Community Infrastructure

Future water needs identified in 2004 and updated for 2014
City is fully in compliance with DEQ, no consent orders in effect.
City street maintenance increased priority annual street expenses exceed \$3.5 million

4. Economic Development/Local Jobs

1/4 Cent sales tax renewed until 2023
Existing industry expansion – highly successful \$230m invested in 2018

5. Retail Development/Re-Development

New entertainment venues improved movie theater, Urban Air, The Clubhouse
Existing facades improved – façade grant program in 3rd year
Additional development at Ardmore Commons, renovation of Shops at Ardmore and new development at Market Street

6. Re-Cycling/Beautification

Additional bike lanes and routes throughout the city
3 murals painted across public spaces
Create Ardmore projects including more than 20 uniquely painted fire hydrants
